

## Georgia PBL Outstanding Members Award

This award is designated for student members who have been loyal and committed members of their local chapter and of Georgia PBL. Chapter advisers or a local chapter officer may nominate up to three members for consideration for this award, one of whom must **not** be a local officer. State officers are not eligible for this award. Winners of this award will be recognized at the State Conference in Atlanta in April.

### Eligibility:

- Only the local chapter adviser or a local chapter officer may nominate and submit the criteria and narrative for a member
- The member must be a paid member on record with the national FBLA-PBL office
- The member must be in good standing with his/her home college
- The member must be an active member of the organization and a currently enrolled student
- The local chapter adviser must compose and submit a letter of support for the student
- The member **must not** be the local chapter nominee for Who's Who in PBL award.

### Criteria:

Please have the nominating adviser or local chapter officer complete the form below. Following each criterion, please key a supporting narrative. For example, for criterion #7, "Member has been a paid member for all or part of one semester," the narrative could read:

*7. Brad's membership was paid on January 15, 2016.*

It is not a requirement that all criteria be achieved by the nominated student. The points to the right of each criterion are the total points available for that criterion. A review panel will designate all or some of the points for each criterion and the total number of points for each nominated student will be calculated. Once all students' criteria sheets have been totaled, the top nominated students will achieve the award not to exceed 1% of the total state PBL Membership. That is, if the state membership is 721, then a maximum of 7 students will receive the award.
